

Requirements for STEM Internship

- Employer must offer an internship for a specified time frame, in one of the Colorado Career Clusters:
 - Business, Marketing & Public Administration
 - Agriculture, Natural Resources & Energy
 - o STEM, Arts, Design & Information Technology
 - Skilled Trades & Technical Sciences
 - o Health Science, Criminal Justice & Public Safety
- Internships should be paid, but exceptions can be made for unpaid internships. If the STEM intern will not be covered for Workers Compensation Insurance by the employer special arrangements must be made ahead of time.
- Internships may be for both for profit or non-profit organizations. All other requirements, including Workers Compensation Insurance, must still be addressed.
- Internship must be approved by STEM School Highlands Ranch via the Internship Course Approval Form.

High School Credit for Internship

Students may earn up to .5 elective credits per semester for participation in an approved STEM internship. This will be a pass/fail course. Internships must meet the following requirements:

- Student must have a complete Internship Course Approval Form & Parent/Guardian Permission and Release of Liability For Internship Participation on file with the high school counseling office **before** beginning an internship.
- Internship will be scheduled for a minimum of 75 hours per semester.
- Students who do not attend 85% or more of their scheduled hours will not pass the
 class. Attendance must be verified via Internship Attendance Verification Form which
 must be submitted to the counseling office the last week of the semester in which the
 internship occurs. Failure to submit the Attendance Verification Form by the last day of
 the semester will result in an F.

• Summer internships:

- Internships completed during summer months must have Internship Course Approval Form and Internship Course Approval Form & Parent/Guardian Permission and Release of Liability For Internship Participation on file with the high school counseling office before May 15. No credit will be applied retroactively.
- To pass a summer internship, the Internship Attendance Verification Form must be submitted by August 15. Students do not turn in Attendance Verification will earn an "F."
