Prior to scheduling a Spring college conference, you must:

- Submit a completed PPP by February 14
- Complete all 7 of your ICAP assessments in Naviance
- Complete & submit Parent Statement(s)

Scheduling a Spring conference:

- Once we confirm completion of Naviance assessments and have reviewed your PPP, you will receive an email message with a link to an online appointment scheduler.
- College conferences take approximately 30 minutes. Please be sure to select a half-hour (30 minute) slot. Parents are welcome to attend these meetings.
