# Financial Aid Impact

Students who are not making Satisfactory Academic Progress in college courses are not eligible for financial aid.

- Maintain a 2.0 unweighted GPA
- Earn credit on 67.7% or more of course credits

# Expectations for Participation in Off-Campus CE

- Read & respond to emails from both institutions within 48 hours.
- CE students must participate in State Mandated Testing like on campus STEM students.
- Changes in course enrollment must be submitted & approved in writing and entered on the [course enrollment form](#)
- ALL deadlines & paperwork must be submitted on time.

# Conduct at STEM

- Off-campus students may ONLY be on STEM's campus for courses they are enrolled in, school sanctioned extracurricular activities, or to meet with a counselor.
