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- Co-Presidents Report: As discussed at our unofficial meeting on Aug 27th, There will be no "official" in person meetings or events until further notice.
  - New Teacher incentive was discussed to be reduced to \$75 per teacher (Previously \$150 per teacher) and we discussed a returning teacher incentive. We need to vote to re-appropriate funds and add an additional budget. Admin said the teachers have not been promised anything from PTO.
  - Teacher/staff gifts were discussed to be in the form of gift cards for this year (Due to COVID) and on campus food will need to be catered.
  - Teacher grants were discussed to be streamlined with grants under \$200 using a new form, however after meeting with the Admin they would like our Teacher Grants to stay focused on larger items. I reached out to the admin about how to best communicate teacher grants and we need to get the word into the Teacher Newsletter via Nicole Bostel, we can also send communication to the admin for an email blast to teachers.
  - The Parent Liaison budget was discussed as \$100 to the teacher with 4 parent attendees of PTO/SAC meetings. Do we want to implement punch cards?
  - Change to STEM Gives dates so as to not compete with Boosterthon:
  - I would like to propose an additional water refill station for the HS. The one currently provided as a gift from the class of 2019 is not in use and HS kids and teachers are needing to travel to the MS to refill their water bottles. It has been proposed that we donate disposable water

bottles and then provide recycle bins for empty bottles until the situation is resolved. I would also like to note we funded two water dispensers for the HS back in 2019 but I am only aware that one was installed??
