



 - Please complete by Monday, Aug. 5.


Communications Pathways

Need Translation or Interpretation Services

Parents with limited English proficiency have a right to be provided oral and/or written information in a language they can understand about any program, service, or activity that is provided to parents who are proficient in English (i.e., parent-teacher conferences, language assistance programs, special education meetings and consents, grievance procedures). Parents also have a right to access language assistance.

Families who need translation services need to complete the Request for Language Assistance Form.

Need Translation or Interpretation Services

Argo Translations and Website Tools

To support our families' translation needs, STEM utilizes Argo Translation. It is an on-demand service with interpreters available in 230+ languages. We also can access video interpretation for American Sign Language (ASL). This tool can be accessed at parent-teacher conferences, special education, and other formal program meetings, and settings across the school.

- <u>Microsoft Translator</u> (Microsoft Edge Browser)
- <u>Firefox Translation Add-On</u> (Firefox Browser)

The stemk12.org website now has a feature that allows for families to select the language they need the website translated into. 
