

Express Check-In Update

- DCSD Express Check-In is open and we are asking all families to complete this step (Phase One) by Monday, Aug. 5.
 - If having difficulty with DCSD Express Check-In, please call DCSD IT. We cannot help with this part.
- STEM's Express Check-In (Phase Two) was emailed on Saturday, July 27.
 - Email includes the STEM Express Check-In Google Form
 - Please complete by Monday, Aug. 5.

Volunteering and giving to STEM are vital to the success of our school. Our school has a charter that requests a commitment of 30 volunteer hours per family (15 hours per single-parent family).

- Every \$20 of donated items translates to one volunteer hour.
 - Remember, the law states that you cannot deduct the value of your time.
 - The IRS does not allow a charitable deduction for volunteering your services.
 - By IRS definition, charitable contributions represent gifts given without reciprocity.
 - Our donation policy is that every \$20 donated equates to one hour of volunteer time.

Volunteer Hours Donation

- Many families have asked if they can just make a donation to cover their volunteer hours.
- We are finally able to accommodate that request. If you'd rather make a monetary donation to go toward your volunteer hours, click the button below and select Volunteer Hours Donation.
- Please remember that if you select this option you cannot claim this donation on your taxes at the end of the year.

Get Connected by Galaxy Digital

- We've partnered with Get Connected by Galaxy Digital to assist us with our Volunteer Coordination and Management. Get Connected is a secure volunteer management solution for K-12 Schools.
- Our new platform will be set to launch the first week of school.
- This new platform will allow families to sign up for volunteer opportunities, log their hours and also see an interactive dashboard to see how far they are from reaching their volunteer hour goal.

Background Checks

- Certain volunteer positions will require volunteers to complete a detailed background check prior to volunteering.
 - Volunteers will be notified in advance if this is needed.
- Please also remember that all volunteers who come during school hours will also be run through our Raptor Check-In System using their Driver's License.

School Accountability Committee

- Colo state law requires every school to have a SAC committee
- 4+ Parents, 1 Elementary Teacher, 1 Secondary Teacher, PTO Rep, Administrator, and Community Rep
- Purpose of SAC is to be an advisory committee
 - Inform and encourage participation from parents and school community
- SAC provides recommendations regarding
 - School's overall performance Unified Improvement Plan
 - Budget priorities/requests
 - Parent and School community concerns related to school performance or safety issues

School Accountability Committee

- Meetings are typically 3rd Wednesday of each month during school year
- Provide presentations on pertinent topics
 - Examples: Tri-County Health, STEM Counseling Team, Standards Based Learning
- Meeting agendas defined based on SAC responsibilities and community feedback
 - Include reports from STEM Admin, Teachers, PTO, Community Rep, DAC Rep
- Subcommittees
 - UIP development
 - Administer Parent survey and review feedback
 - Communications
 - SAC Bylaws Update
- SAC Representative(s) participate in STEM Diversity, Equity & Inclusion committee

KOSON/STEM Board of Directors
