

## HIGH SCHOOL WORK STUDY PROGRAM



The National Security Agency (NSA) is looking for high school juniors who possess outstanding academic credentials in the areas of business, computer technology, engineering, graphic arts, manufacturing, construction, Chinese language, Russian language or humanities.

The High School Work Study (HSWS) Program is designed for high school students who plan to participate in a school-sponsored work experience program during their senior year. Students are hired to participate in a paid part-time internship from September - August for a minimum of 4 hours a day, Monday through Friday.

Please Note: Your high school must participate in early work release.

Applications are accepted online at IntelligenceCareers.gov starting September 1.

## Who is Eligible to Apply?

Applicants should have a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on 4.0 scale. Applicants must be **16 years of age by December 31 of high school Junior year**, be citizens of the United States and eligible to be granted a security clearance.

## **Field of Study**

Office Assistant: Must have completed at least two business or technical computer courses

Computer Aide/Engineering Specialist/Tech: Must have completed at least two technical computer courses

**Printing/Graphic Arts & Model Shop:** Must be enrolled in manufacturing or printing/graphic arts courses at a technical high school

Facilities/Logistics: Must be enrolled in construction, engineering, project management or manufacturing at a technical high school

**Chinese Language:** Must be enrolled in advanced Chinese courses (Chinese 5 or higher)

Russian Language: Must be enrolled in advanced Russian courses (Russian 4 or higher)

Intelligence Analysis Alde: Must be enrolled in at least one advanced English course and at least one advanced humanities course (government, history, etc.). Must have completed at least two business or technical computer courses.
