- over 200 names on open enrollment for next school year.
- attrition is expected about 25% between 8th and 9th same at all schools.
- Naviance program to help goal set for high school. Help high school, college and career planning. Good tool to move students forward. Bonnie or Daniel will speak more on this next time.
- 8th Grade Career Expo 94 8th graders to Douglas County Fairgrounds. 75 to 80 different employers. Employers did mock interviews. Kids were able to ask questions about the different careers. Over 3600 kids attended. Look at a career fair at the school or we could add to Douglas County's career day.
- K-5 Update nothing new to update. Dr. Euker took information to the board.
